6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to compensation of public service  
7 commissioners; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 42.05.110 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 42.05.110. COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF COMMISSION. (a)

11 Members of the commission are entitled to the per diem established  
12 by law for other boards and commissions and shall be paid for their  
13 necessary travel expense.

14 (b) The annual salary for each member of the commission is  
15 \$5,000 to be paid in approximately equal monthly payments. The  
16 chairman of the commission shall receive an additional \$300 a year  
17 during his tenure as chairman.

18 \* Sec. 2. This Act is retroactive to July 1, 1969.

19 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
20 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
