6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the certification of documents."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 09.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 09.65.C12. CERTIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS. (a) Any matter re-
10 quired or authorized to be supported, evidenced, established, or
11 proved by the sworn statement, declaration, verification, certificate,
12 oath, or affidavit, in writing of the person making it (other than a
13 deposition, an acknowledgement, or an oath of office, or an oath re-
14 quired to be taken before a specified official other than a notary
15 public), may be supported, evidenced, established, or proved, by the
16 person certifying in writing "under penalty of perjury" that the matter
17 is true and accurate. The certification shall state the date and place
18 of execution, the fact that no notary public or other official empowered
19 to administer oaths is available, and the following:

"I certify under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true
21 and accurate."

(b) A person who wilfully and falsely executes a certification
23 under penalty of perjury is guilty of perjury.
