6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to procedure upon application for  
7 state participation in federal programs."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 37 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 40. FEDERAL PROGRAM PARTICIPATION.

11 Sec. 37.40.010. APPLICATION. When a state department or agency  
12 makes application, enters into a tentative agreement or contract, or  
13 submits state plans for participation in and for grants of federal  
14 funds which have not been previously approved by the legislature, the  
15 department or agency making application or tentative agreement or sub-  
16 mitting plans shall at that time, by sending the appropriate number of  
17 copies to the executive director of the Legislative Affairs Agency,  
18 notify the chairman of the Alaska Legislative Council and the senate  
19 and house finance committees on forms and in the manner prescribed by  
20 the legislative council.

21 Sec. 37.40.020. AMENDMENTS. When the application, tentative  
22 agreement or contract or state plan is amended, the department or agency  
23 shall, by sending the appropriate number of copies to the executive  
24 director of the Legislative Affairs Agency, notify the chairmen of the  
25 Alaska Legislative Council and the senate and house finance committees  
26 on forms and in the manner prescribed by the legislative council.

27 Sec. 37.40.030. YEARLY REPORTS. The department or agency comply-  
28 ing with secs. 10 and 20 of this chapter shall furnish, by sending the  
29 appropriate number of copies to the executive director of the Legislative

1 Affairs Agency, the chairman of the Alaska Legislative Council and the  
2 senate and house finance committees a progress report on matters re-  
3 quiring notice in sec. 10 of this chapter, at least once in each  
4 twelve-month period following the date of the notice in addition to a  
5 final report of the disposition of the matter.
