For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to school lands; and providing for
7 an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 38.05.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10

(e) The sale, lease or other disposal of school lands under the
11 jurisdiction of the department shall be made by the commissioner in
12 accordance with the provisions of this chapter. School lands may be
13 exchanged for (1) state lands, (2) privately owned lands, (3) vacant,
14 unappropriated and unreserved public lands and (4) lands owned by a
15 city, borough or other public entity. In the case of unequal values,
16 cash may be used to equalize land values. When the department deter-
17 mines that it is in the best interest of the state to dispose of
18 the school lands located within an organized borough or city of any
19 class, the borough or city is authorized, and has preference for six
20 months after notice, to acquire the land at the appraised value by
21 purchase or exchange of land acceptable to the department. No sale,
22 lease, exchange or other disposal of school lands may be made without
23 the approval of the State Board of Education.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
25 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
