6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Transportation
7 Commission; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 42.07.101 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 42.07.101. EMPLOYMENT AND COMPENSATION OF PERSONNEL. (a)

11 The commission may employ engineers, hearing officers, experts, clerks,
12 accountants, and other agents and assistants it considers necessary.
13 Employees and agents of the commission, other than legal counsel, are
14 in the classified service under AS 39.25.

15 (b) In addition to its staff of regular employees the commission
16 may contract for and engage the services of the consultants, [AND]
17 experts and hearing officers the commission considers necessary for the
18 purpose of developing information or conducting studies, investigations,
19 hearings or other proceedings.

20 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
21 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
