6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to weldments."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 08.99.050 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 08.99.050. QUALIFICATIONS OF BOARD MEMBERS. Each member of
10 the board shall be a citizen of the United States and a resident of
11 the state. At least three members shall be practicing engineers with
12 a minimum of five years' experience as a practicing engineer. All
13 members shall have extensive experience in the welding or construction
14 industry.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 08.99.080 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

16 (9) promulgate rules and regulations concerning quality
17 and type of welds required in specific areas of industry and construc-
18 tion and designate reporting procedures which industry shall follow
19 to certify compliance with these quality standards.
