6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to compensation of judicial officers;  
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 22.05.140(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The chief justice shall receive \$32,000 [\$30,000] annually,  
11 and each associate justice shall receive \$31,000 [\$28,000] annually as  
12 compensation. The compensation is payable monthly in 12 equal instal-  
13 lments. Compensation of the chief justice or of an associate justice  
14 shall not be diminished during his term of office, unless by general  
15 law applying to all salaried officers of the state.

16 \* Sec. 2. AS 22.10.190(a) is amended to read:

17 (a) Each supreme court judge shall receive \$29,000 [\$26,500]  
18 annually, as compensation, payable monthly in 12 equal installments.  
19 The compensation of a judge shall not be diminished during his term  
20 of office, unless by general law applying to all salaried officers of  
21 the state.

22 \* Sec. 3. AS 22.15.220(a) is amended to read:

23 (a) Each district judge shall receive \$24,000 [\$19,000] annually  
24 as compensation, payable monthly in 12 equal installments.

25 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on July 16, 1970.
