6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of electrical  
7 contractors."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.40.190 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 08.40.190. EXCLUSION. This chapter does not apply to any  
11 person engaged in (1) electrical construction and maintenance of  
12 electrical wiring for the generation and distribution of electrical  
13 current where the wiring is an integral part of a system owned and  
14 operated by a public service corporation or the light and power  
15 department of a municipality and the work is performed by the employees  
16 of that public utility or municipality; (2) the operation, maintenance,  
17 installation, or repair of telephone, telegraph, signal or communica-  
18 tion systems, or of a television or radio broadcasting station; (3)  
19 the manufacture or repair of electrical apparatus or equipment; or  
20 (4) electrical work, the cost of which does not exceed \$5,000,  
21 involving residences or small commercial establishments in communities  
22 (A) which have a population of under 500, or (B) which are over 50  
23 miles by air or water transportation from the business place of an  
24 electrical contractor licensed under this chapter; however, work within  
25 the exclusionary provisions of this subsection is subject to the  
26 inspection provisions of sec. 70 of this chapter and must follow the  
27 regulations regarding workmanship promulgated in the administrative  
28 code. A person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty  
29 of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is liable for a fine not to

exceed \$300.
