For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to approval of local school district budgets; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 07.15.330(d) is amended to read:

(d) The school board shall submit the annual budget for the

11

following school year to the assembly by April 1 for approval of the

12

total amount. Within 30 days after receipt of the budget the assembly

13

shall determine the total amount of money to be made available from

14

local sources for school purposes, and shall furnish the school board

15

with a statement of the sum to be made available. If the assembly does

16

not, within 30 days, furnish the school board with a statement of the

17

sum to be made available, the amount requested in the budget is auto-

18

matically approved. If the total amount approved by the assembly and

19

the total amount submitted by the school board differ, and the board

20

elects not to concur in the amount approved by the assembly, the

21

respective amounts shall be submitted to the voters of the district

22

for approval of either the amount submitted by the board or the amount

23

approved by the assembly. A special election on the question shall be

24

held at the earliest time permitted and in the manner prescribed by

25

law for special municipal elections. Not later than the day following

26

certification of election results [MAY 31], the assembly shall appropri-

27

ate the amount to be made available from local sources, as determined

28

by the election, from money available for the purpose.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1970.
