For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to fish and game licensing and registration procedures; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.05.250 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

11

(14) establishment of the times and dates during which the

12

issuance of fish and game licenses, permits and registrations

13

and the transfer of permits and registrations between registration

14

areas, game management units or subunits, is allowed.

15

* Sec. 2. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

16

Sec. 16.05.065. APPLICATION EXTENSION. (a) The commissioner

17

shall extend the time and dates during which application may be made

18

for fish or game licensing or registration if he finds that

19

(1) the conservation and management of the fish or game

20

resource will not be affected adversely and

21

(2) the failure to timely apply is the result of excusable

22

neglect.

23

(b) Upon the granting of an extension to an applicant and upon

24

the applicant's compliance with this chapter, the commissioner of

25

revenue or his authorized deputy shall issue the appropriate licenses

26

and tags.

27

(c) The fee for an extension granted under this section is \$45.

* Sec. 3. The regulations in 5 AAC presently in effect relating to the

29

times and dates employed in the issuance of fish and game licenses, permits

1 and registrations, and the transfer of permits and registrations between
2 registration areas, game management units or subunits, not in conflict with
3 this Act, shall remain in effect until repealed or amended by the Board of
4 Fish and Game.

5 * Sec. 4. It is the intent of the legislature that, prior to the First
6 Session of the Seventh Legislature, the Board of Fish and Game and the
7 Department of Fish and Game shall review AS 16.05.065 and, if necessary,
8 make recommendations to the legislature for changes in AS 16.05.065.

9 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
10 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
