4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to construction of an air-
6 strip at Twin Hills, Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the village of Twin Hills has experienced substantial growth
9 in its more recent history; and

10 WHEREAS the state has recently acknowledged the viability of this
11 village by the establishment of a school in Twin Hills which will in turn
12 precipitate further growth; and

13 WHEREAS the only access to this village is by boat up the Togiak River;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, during the long periods of freeze-up and break-up on the
16 Togiak River, the village becomes virtually isolated from the rest of the
17 state;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct
19 the Department of Public Works to construct a bush airstrip at Twin Hills.
