9 Programs, with amendments.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 WHEREAS the state has been eligible to receive federal matching funds
12 for medical assistance programs in a sum not less than 50 per cent nor greater
13 than 83 per cent since the enactment of federal legislation in 1965; and

14 WHEREAS many of our citizens are in dire need of the medical assistance
15 provided for in this federal legislation; and

16 WHEREAS the state department or agency working in the field of welfare
17 and medical care and related activity must submit a plan showing a state
18 program which conforms with the requirements of the federal act; and

19 WHEREAS this department is the state Department of Health and Welfare;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature respectfully requests the Governor
21 to direct the Department of Health and Welfare to submit a state plan for
22 medical assistance to the Secretary of the United States Department of
23 Health, Education and Welfare, which plan conforms with the requirements of
24 Title 42, U.S.C., ch. 7, subch. XIX, with amendments; and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor submit this plan and all enabling
26 legislation necessary to implement state participation in this medical
27 assistance program to the Sixth Legislature, First Session, for legislative
28 consideration.
