5 Requesting a study of state space
6 requirements in Nome, Kotzebue and
7 Point Barrow.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS as the state has grown and continues to grow, in terms of
10 population and the economy, more demands are made on state government; and

11 WHEREAS, in order to meet the increased demands for expanded services,
12 the government must increase its personnel and facilities; and

13 WHEREAS, because of space limitations in Nome, Kotzebue and Point
14 Barrow, state offices and personnel are widely scattered over large areas
15 and in many different facilities which results in inefficiencies and lack
16 of coordination; and

17 WHEREAS there is a definite need for a comprehensive study to be con-
18 ducted of the state space requirements in Nome, Kotzebue and Point Barrow
19 regarding all facets of state governmental operations; and

20 WHEREAS the study should determine what the requirements of state
21 government are, what will be needed, cost figures and suggestions for funding;
22 and

23 WHEREAS with regard to Nome, the study should inquire into the feasi-
24 bility of utilizing the state-owned North Star Hotel as a state office
25 building;

26 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the division of
27 buildings in the Department of Public Works to conduct a study of state space
28 requirements in Nome, Kotzebue and Point Barrow for all state governmental
29 operations, to determine the feasibility of utilizing the North Star Hotel

1 in Nome for a state office building, and to report the findings and recom-
2 mendations to the Sixth Legislature, Second Session.
