2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to educational television.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS educational television has the potential for providing most
8 remote villages with timely and relevant programming of the quality received
9 by larger communities; and

10 WHEREAS the Columbia Broadcasting System has recently developed a
11 seemingly simple and inexpensive means of providing both educational and
12 entertainment closed-circuit television called "Electronic Video Recording"
13 (E.V.R.); and

14 WHEREAS adoption of this system by the state would appear to be one
15 effective means of greatly enhancing the educational standards and
16 materials of the smaller and more remote villages;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the governor is respectfully requested to direct
18 the Department of Education, in conjunction with other appropriate state
19 agencies, to investigate the feasibility and probable costs of installing
20 the E.V.R. system as an educational tool in those communities without
21 television reception capabilities, and of establishing a central E.V.R.
22 "mailing library" program under the auspices of the Department of Education.
