3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to a statewide land-use plan.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Alaska's greatest asset is its land, with vast areas available  
8 for habitation, recreation, development of resources, and wilderness areas;  
9 and

10 WHEREAS the tragic experiences in other states of misuse of their  
11 land and of conflicts among the various uses of land should prompt Alaska  
12 to engage in extensive land-use planning; and

13 WHEREAS at present Alaska has no statewide comprehensive land-use  
14 plan;

15 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct  
16 the Department of Natural Resources to begin work on a statewide comprehen-  
17 sive land-use plan, and to report to the Seventh Legislature, First Session  
18 on the progress of this work.
