2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 10

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the extension of Armed
6 Forces television to certain areas of
7 the state.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the solution of the vast communications problems of Alaska has
10 been made an item of the highest priority by both the legislative and execu-
11 tive branches of government; and

12 WHEREAS different aspects of these problems are being attacked at vari-
13 ous levels of state government; and

14 WHEREAS the goal of the numerous approaches is the ultimate integration
15 of all communications into one modern, comprehensive, efficient system; and

16 WHEREAS recently, through an agreement between the Department of Defense
17 and the state, an arrangement has been worked out, contingent upon legis-
18 lative appropriation, whereby facilities to be located at Naknek and
19 Dillingham would utilize Armed Forces television programming from the King
20 Salmon Air Force Base to provide television to much of the Bristol Bay area;
21 and

22 WHEREAS it is conceivable that this same type of arrangement could be
23 worked out for other areas of the state where Armed Forces television is
24 available; and

25 WHEREAS the communications hardware used to provide this service could
26 be later integrated into an overall communications network for Alaska;

27 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the
28 Department of Public Works to analyze the feasibility of providing Armed
29 Forces television to areas, other than Naknek and Dillingham, surrounding

1 military bases and to request the agreement and cooperation of the Department
2 of Defense in providing this service.
