5 Relating to restaking winter trails

6 between certain villages in Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS, at the present time, winter trails are not being restaked from

9 (1) Bethel to Nunapitchuk to Kasiglook and

10 (2) Bethel to Eek to Guinagak to Goodnews and

11 (3) Bethel to Tuntatuliag to Kongiganak to Kwigillingok to
12 Kipnuk to Chefornek to Nightmute to Tucksuk Bay to Tununak; and

13 WHEREAS these trails are essential arteries for the transportation of
14 supplies and are also in constant use by subsistence hunters and trappers;
15 and

16 WHEREAS travel for the inhabitants of these areas is carried on at the
17 constant risk of life even without the added danger of becoming lost;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska respectfully
19 requests the Governor to direct the Department of Highways to restake these
20 winter trails which are so essential to existence during these months, and
21 to complete the project by the close of 1970.
