Relating to the improvement of the

School House Road in Delta Junction.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the School House Road in Delta Junction is of poor quality and

9

needs improvement immediately; and

10

WHEREAS this road is highly traveled for the nine months of the year

11

when school is in session; and

12

WHEREAS the dust is such that visibility is extremely limited during

13

two-thirds of this time during heavy road and foot traffic; and

14

WHEREAS a considerable number of pupils walk to and from school along

15

this road; and

16

WHEREAS the road is so narrow that it is impossible for two vehicles

17

to meet and pass if a pedestrian is using the road; and

18

WHEREAS every effort should be made to improve this road for the

19

safety of children and drivers using it; and

20

WHEREAS the life and safety of school children could be secured by

21

widening and pavement of the School House Road and the construction of a

22

sidewalk along this road; and

23

WHEREAS the expeditious completion of this construction during the

24

summer of 1970 will result in a lessening of the dangers to safety of all

25

who utilize this area;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the

27

Department of Highways to take action in 1970 to improve the School House

Road in Delta Junction.
