5 Relating to the construction of an
6 access road between Wales and Lopp
7 Lagoon.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS roads and highways are essential to the development of trade
10 and commerce in Alaska; and

11 WHEREAS the people of the state, and particularly those of rural Alaska,
12 are presently without the adequate road system they need if this vast state
13 is to be utilized; and

14 WHEREAS it is the policy of the state to do everything possible for
15 making accessible all areas of the state for tourism, mineral exploration,
16 and conservation-conscious industrial development; and

17 WHEREAS the great potential which lies in the Seward Peninsula necessi-
18 tates the early development of road systems; and

19 WHEREAS a feasibility study has already been conducted and the recom-
20 mendation made that an access road be constructed between Wales and Lopp
21 Lagoon on the Seward Peninsula;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct
23 the Department of Highways to construct an access road between Wales, Alaska
24 and Lopp Lagoon.
