3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION
5 Requesting the State Personnel Board
6 to adopt regulations implementing
7 overtime compensation.
8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
9 WHEREAS it is in the interest of the state to compensate its employees
10 for overtime work;
11 BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature requests the State
12 Personnel Board to adopt regulations effective no later than October 1, 1970
13 clarifying the state's policy on compensation for employee overtime work as
14 directed by AS 39.25.150(20). The board is specifically advised that it is
15 the intent of the Legislature that the overtime rate should not be less
16 than the hourly equivalent of the employee's monthly salary or the hourly
17 rate if an employee is compensated on an hourly basis. The board is further
18 advised that the intent of the Legislature is that particular attention be
19 given to compensating those employees whose salaries fall within pay ranges
20 5 through 14. Compensation may be in cash or compensating time off from
21 regular work hours.
