2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 23

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to cutting dog team and snow-
6 mobile portages through certain woods.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS travel time would be greatly reduced by having dog team and
9 snowmobile portage trails cut through the woods from

10 (1) Marshall to Russian Village, and

11 (2) Marshall to Pilot Station to St. Mary's; and

12 WHEREAS this travel is essential in the winter for supplies as well as
13 for subsistence hunters and trappers; and

14 WHEREAS travel by the inhabitants of these areas is fraught with con-
15 stant danger without the present necessity of detouring around thickly wooded
16 areas;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska urges the
18 Department of the Interior to direct the Bureau of Land Management to cut
19 trails through the woods between the villages mentioned.
