2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 24

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to restaking winter trails

6 between certain villages in Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS, at the present time, winter trails are not being restaked
9 from

10 (1) Bethel to Nunapitchuk to Kasiglook and

11 (2) Bethel to Eek to Quinhagak to Goodnews and

12 (3) Bethel to Tuntatuliag to Kongiganak to Kwigillingok to

13 Kipnuk to Chefornak to Nightmute to Tucksuk Bay to Tununak; and

14 WHEREAS these trails are essential arteries for the transportation of
15 supplies and are also in constant use by subsistence hunters and trappers; and

16 WHEREAS travel for the inhabitants of these areas is carried on at the
17 constant risk of life even without the added danger of becoming lost;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska urges the
19 Department of the Interior to direct the Bureau of Land Management to restake
20 these winter trails which are so essential to existence during these months.
