2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 32

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to an air route between
6 Anchorage, Juneau, Minneapolis -
7 St. Paul and Chicago.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the air transportation links between Alaska and the other states
10 of the union are lifelines to the welfare and economy of Alaska; and

11 WHEREAS a new, direct air route between Alaska and the midwest would
12 have a stimulating effect on the economy of Alaska; and

13 WHEREAS such a route could provide the convenience of single carrier
14 service between many points in Alaska to the midwest; and

15 WHEREAS an Alaska midwest route would open up new tourist and cargo
16 markets to Alaska;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature urges the Civil Aeron-
18 autics Board to grant the application of Alaska Airlines to open an air route
19 between Anchorage, Juneau, Minneapolis - St. Paul, and Chicago at the earli-
20 est date possible in order that the people in these areas will be provided a
21 needed service.
