2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 35

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the joint use by the City
6 of Kodiak and the federal government
7 of the Kodiak Naval Station Airport.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Kodiak Municipal Airport at Kodiak, Alaska is short,
10 narrow, rocky and perilous; and

11 WHEREAS the State of Alaska appropriated funds to be used in matching
12 federal aid to airport funds for improvements to the Kodiak Municipal Airport,
13 and

14 WHEREAS the Federal Aviation Agency has refused to use available federal
15 funds for improving Kodiak Municipal Airport pending a complete investigation
16 into the possibility of joint use of the nearby Kodiak Naval Station Airport;
17 and

18 WHEREAS the airport located on the naval station is ideally located and
19 is capable of fulfilling airport requirements for both military and civilian
20 needs; and

21 WHEREAS the City of Kodiak and the Kodiak Naval Station command have
22 been negotiating for some two years in an effort to establish such a joint-
23 use agreement; and

24 WHEREAS proposals for joint-use advanced by the Navy contain financial
25 requirements and operating restrictions which are unacceptable to the City
26 of Kodiak;

27 BE IT RESOLVED that the proper authorities in Washington, D. C. be
28 requested to intercede in this matter and lend their aid and expertise in
29 making existing airport facilities at Kodiak Naval Station available to

1 general aviation of the City of Kodiak.

2 COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable David D.
3 Thomas, Acting Administrator, Federal Aviation Agency; the Honorable John H.
4 Chafee, Department of the Navy; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the
5 Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators, and the Honorable Howard W. Pollock,
6 U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
