5 Requesting a BIA school for

6 Chuloonawick, Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the village of Chuloonawick has a population of 120 people, of
9 which approximately 40 are children; and

10 WHEREAS due to the absence of a school in the village, the families
11 must move each fall to other villages with schools, returning again in June;
12 and

13 WHEREAS the constant moving of these families in order to secure this
14 basic right of elementary education is an undue hardship on their already
15 overburdened lives;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth Alaska State Legislature respectfully
17 requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to establish a BIA school at
18 Chuloonawick, Alaska.

21 Bennett, Commissioner of Indian Affairs; the Honorable Charles A. Richmond,

23 Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators, and to the Honorable
24 Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation
25 in Congress.
