BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Sec. 2 of Art. IV of the Constitution of the State of

11

Alaska is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(b) The chief justice shall be selected by majority vote of the

13

justices of the supreme court. The term of the chief justice shall be

14

for three years.

15

* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this Resolution shall be placed

16

before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity

17

with Section 1, Article XIII, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the

18

election laws of the state.
