SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 10  
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to the electric voting machine.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS there have been occasions during the current legislative session when members have been confused due to the practice of some legislators flipping the voting switch from one position to another; and

WHEREAS in any event it is undesirable for any member of the legislature to see how a colleague votes on any given issue before he himself votes;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate respectfully requests the Legislative Council to direct the executive director of the Legislative Affairs Agency to have the appropriate wiring changes made so that the lights of the voting machine will not be activated until such time as the President asks the body "Has any member failed to vote?"
