6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to first degree murder; and providing  
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 11.15.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 11.15.010. FIRST DEGREE MURDER. (a) A person is guilty of  
11 first degree murder if he kills another person

12 (1) purposely and with deliberate and premeditated malice; or

13 (2) purposely by means of poison.

14 (b) A person is guilty of first degree murder if he perpetrates or  
15 attempts to perpetrate arson, burglary, escape, kidnapping, lewd or  
16 lascivious acts toward a child, rape or robbery, which results in the  
17 death of another person.

18 (c) A person who is convicted of first degree murder shall be  
19 sentenced to imprisonment for not less than 20 years to life.

20 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
21 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
