6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to university and college tuition;  
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 14.40.065. TUITION. No basic tuition fee may be charged a  
11 resident of Alaska during his freshman or sophomore year at the Uni-  
12 versity of Alaska or a college or department established under it.  
13 The state, subject to appropriations for the purpose, shall reimburse  
14 the University for tuition fees which except for this section would be  
15 payable by students. This section does not exclude charges to students  
16 for textbooks, room and board and other nonacademic fees.

17 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

18 Sec. 14.40.605. TUITION. No basic tuition fee may be charged a  
19 resident of Alaska who attends a community college established under  
20 secs. 560 - 640 of this chapter. The state, subject to appropriations  
21 for the purpose, shall reimburse the university for tuition fees which  
22 except for this section would be payable by students. This section  
23 does not exclude charges to students for textbooks, room and board and  
24 other nonacademic fees.

25 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1971.
