5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act clarifying certain benefits for dependent
7 children under the Alaska Workmen's Compensation
8 Act."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 23.30.195(a)(1) is amended to read:

11 (1) If there be a surviving wife or dependent husband and
12 no child of the deceased [UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS], to the wife or
13 dependent husband;

14 * Sec. 2. AS 23.30.195(a)(2) is amended to read:

15 (2) If there be a surviving wife or dependent husband and
16 a surviving child of the deceased [UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS], one
17 half to the surviving wife or dependent husband and the other half
18 to the surviving child;

19 * Sec. 3. AS 23.30.195(a)(3) is amended to read:

20 (3) If there be a surviving child of the deceased [UNDER
21 THE AGE OF 18 YEARS], but no surviving wife or dependent husband, then
22 to the child.

23 * Sec. 4. AS 23.30.215(a)(3) is amended to read:

24 (3) If there is one or more surviving children of the
25 deceased, but no surviving wife or dependent husband, then for the
26 support of the child or children 35 per cent of the average weekly
27 wages of the deceased [OR UNTIL THE CHILD OR CHILDREN REACH THE AGE
28 OF 19];
