6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to compensation of state employees;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.27.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 39.27.010. BASIC SALARY SCHEDULE. The following monthly
11 basic salary schedule is approved as the pay plan for classified and
12 partially exempt employees of the State of Alaska:

9 * Sec. 3. AS 39.27 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 39.27.025. SWING AND GRAVEYARD SHIFT DIFFERENTIALS. (a)
 11 Classified and partially exempt state employees who regularly work a
 12 "swing" shift beginning between 12:00 noon and 7:59 p.m. are entitled
 13 to a one-step increase over their normal pay established by this
 14 chapter.

15 (b) Classified and partially exempt state employees who regularly
 16 work a "graveyard" shift beginning between 8:00 p.m. and 3:59 a.m. are
 17 entitled to a two-step increase over their normal pay established by
 18 this chapter.

19 * Sec. 4. It is the intent of the legislature that all permanent em-
 20 ployees of the legislative branch of the government shall receive pay incre-
 21 ments as comparable as possible to those provided the classified and
 22 partially exempt employees in secs. 10 - 20 of this chapter.

23 * Sec. 5. AS 24.15.010 is amended to read:

24 Sec. 24.15.010. LEGISLATIVE PER DIEM. The rate of per diem
 25 instead of subsistence for each member of the legislature is \$35 for
 26 each day [THE FIRST 90 DAYS] of a legislative session. The per diem
 27 is also payable for those days of necessary travel to and from
 28 sessions.

29 * Sec. 6. Sec. 5 of this Act is retroactive to April 10, 1971.

1 * Sec. 7. Secs. 5 and 6 of this Act take effect on the day after their
2 passage and approval or on the day they become law without approval.

3 * Sec. 8. Sec. 3 of this Act takes effect on January 16, 1972.

4 * Sec. 9. Secs. 1, 2 and 4 of this Act take effect on July 16, 1971.
