6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to advisory school boards; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.14.170 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (c) In communities qualifying for three-member advisory school
11 boards under (a) of this section, voters qualified under sec. 180 of
12 this chapter may increase the board to five members by referendum. In
13 communities qualifying for five-member advisory school boards under
14 (a) of this section, voters qualified under sec. 180 of this chapter
15 may increase the board to seven members by referendum.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 14.14.190(c) is amended to read:

17 (c) If a three-member board advisory school board is increased
18 to a five-member advisory school board [BECAUSE OF INCREASED ENROLL-
19 MENT], the two additional members are elected for terms of two years
20 and three years respectively. Thereafter, all members are elected to
21 three-year terms. If a five-member advisory school board is increased
22 to a seven-member advisory school board, the two additional members are
23 elected for terms of two years and three years respectively. There-
24 after, all members are elected to three-year terms and until a
25 successor takes office.

26 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
27 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
