functions by the Alaska State Housing Authority."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 18.55 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 18.55.025. REQUIRED DELEGATION OF POWERS AND FUNCTIONS.

Upon adoption of an ordinance by the governing body of a first class  
12 city or any borough requesting the delegation to the municipality of  
13 any powers or functions of the authority, the authority shall delegate  
14 the powers or functions requested and may revoke the delegated powers  
15 or functions only upon adoption of an ordinance by the governing body  
16 requesting revocation.

Sec. 18.55.720. AUTHORITY MAY DELEGATE FUNCTIONS TO MUNICIPALITIES

AND PUBLIC BODIES. The authority may delegate to a municipality or  
20 other public body any of its powers or functions [WITH RESPECT TO THE  
21 PLANNING OR UNDERTAKING OF AN URBAN RENEWAL PROJECT] in the area in  
22 which the municipality or public body is authorized to act, and the  
23 municipality or public body may carry out or perform these powers  
24 and functions for the authority.
