6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the taking of game by nonresidents."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.05.407(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) It is unlawful for a nonresident to hunt, pursue or take
10 brown bear, grizzly bear, polar bear, moose, mountain goat or sheep
11 in this state, unless personally accompanied by a person who is licensed
12 as a master guide, registered guide or assistant guide by the depart-
13 ment, or who is personally accompanied by a resident Alaskan over 19
14 years of age who is the spouse of or is related by blood within and
15 including the second degree of kindred. A person who applies for a
16 nonresident big game tag for the taking of an animal specified in this
17 section shall first furnish to the state, on a form provided by the
18 state, an affidavit showing that he will be accompanied in his hunt
19 by a person who is qualified under the terms of this section. A person
20 who falsifies the required affidavit is guilty of perjury.
