6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of construction
7 contractors."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.18.121(e) is repealed.

10 * Sec. 2. AS 08.18.121 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

11 (f) If the commissioner of labor determines that a person is
12 acting as a contractor in violation of secs. 11 - 171 of this chapter,
13 he shall give written notice prohibiting further action by the person
14 as a contractor. The prohibition continues until the person has
15 submitted evidence acceptable to the commissioner of labor showing that
16 the violation has been corrected.

17 (g) A person affected by an order issued under this chapter may
18 seek equitable relief preventing the commissioner of labor from
19 enforcing the order. No relief may be granted by the court until the
20 contractor alleges and proves that he was registered at all times
21 pertinent to the lawsuit.

23 Sec. 08.18.131. INJUNCTION. In an action instituted in the
24 superior court by the commissioner of labor or his representative a
25 person acting in the capacity of a contractor in violation of this
26 chapter may be enjoined from doing so.
