6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the powers and duties of the
7 Public Utilities Commission; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 42.05.141 is amended by adding new paragraphs to read:

11 (6) appear personally or by counsel and represent the
12 interests and welfare of the state in all matters and proceedings
13 involving a public utility pending before an officer, department,
14 board, commission or court of the state or of another state or the
15 United States and to intervene in, protest, resist, or advocate the
16 granting, denial or modification of any petition, application,
17 complaint or other proceeding;

18 (7) examine witnesses and offer evidence in any proceeding
19 affecting the state and initiate or participate in judicial proceedings
20 to the extent necessary to protect and promote the interests of the
21 state.

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
23 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
