6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to persons serving alcoholic beverages; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 04.10.040(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) A person [CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES,] over the age of 19  
11 years and of good moral character, may be regularly employed as a  
12 waiter or waitress in an establishment operating under a beverage  
13 dispensary license only if he obtains a permit issued by the board,  
14 which permit evidences good moral character as measured by objective  
15 criteria adopted by regulation in accordance with the Administrative  
16 Procedure Act (AS 44.62). [THE DUTIES OF WAITRESSES EMPLOYED THEREIN  
17 SHALL BE CONFINED TO TAKING ORDERS AND SERVING BEVERAGES, ALCOHOLIC  
18 OR OTHERWISE, AND FOOD.] Persons [WAITRESSES] employed under this  
19 section may not solicit or encourage the purchase of beverages, alco-  
20 holic or otherwise, by a patron of the premises, whether the beverage  
21 is for the patron or for another. No waitress or waiter may accept any  
22 beverage, alcoholic or otherwise, purchased for them by a patron of the  
23 establishment. [NO WAITRESS MAY ACCEPT ANY BEVERAGE, ALCOHOLIC OR  
24 OTHERWISE, PURCHASED FOR HER BY A PATRON OF THE ESTABLISHMENT. THE  
25 LICENSED PREMISES MUST APPLY FOR AND RECEIVE A PERMIT FROM THE BOARD TO  
26 EMPLOY FEMALE PERSONS AS WAITRESSES.]

27 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
28 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
