6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to persons serving alcoholic beverages; and providing for an effective date."
7

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.10.040(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) A person [CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES,] over the age of 19
11 years and of good moral character, may be regularly employed as a
12 waiter or waitress in an establishment operating under a beverage
13 dispensary license. The duties of waitresses employed therein shall
14 be confined to taking orders and serving beverages, alcoholic or
15 otherwise, and food. Persons [WAITRESSES] employed under this section
16 may not solicit or encourage the purchase of beverages, alcoholic or
17 otherwise, by a patron of the premises, whether the beverage is for
18 the patron or for another. No employee of the licensee [WAITRESS] may
19 accept any beverage, alcoholic or otherwise, purchased for the employee
20 [HER] by a patron of the establishment. The licensee, manager or
21 designated person in charge are severally responsible for the conduct
22 of their employees [THE LICENSED PREMISES MUST APPLY FOR AND RECEIVE
23 A PERMIT FROM THE BOARD TO EMPLOY FEMALE PERSONS AS WAITRESSES].

24 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
25 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
