6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to historical sites and monuments."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 38.25.020 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 38.25.020. FINANCIAL SUPPORT AND CONTROL. State-owned  
10 historical sites and monuments owned or purchased by the state are  
11 under the control of the Department of Natural Resources and their  
12 maintenance shall be covered in the appropriations made to that  
13 department. Privately owned historical sites and monuments are  
14 eligible to receive state support for the reconstruction, rehabilita-  
15 tion or maintenance of the site or monument if it is kept accessible  
16 to the general public and application for partial support is made  
17 in conformity with regulations promulgated by the commissioner of  
18 natural resources.
