6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of commercial
7 fishermen; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05.450(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The commissioner of revenue or his authorized deputy shall
11 issue a license to each qualified person who files a written application
12 in person, at places in the state designated by the commissioner, con-
13 taining the reasonable information required by the commissioner
14 together with the required fee. The application shall be simple in
15 form and shall be executed by the applicant [OR HIS AGENT] under the
16 penalty of perjury.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05.450 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

18 (c) A commercial fishing gear license for a specific registration
19 area may be issued only within the specific area for which the license
20 is requested; the license may be renewed at offices designated by
21 the commissioner outside the specific area but inside the state.

22 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on January 1, 1972.
