7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 18.80.270 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (b) In addition to the penalty provided for in (a) of this sec-
10 tion, a person, under the jurisdiction of a board under AS 08.01.010
11 who wilfully engages in an unlawful discriminatory conduct prohibited
12 by this chapter, or wilfully resists, prevents, impedes or interferes
13 with the commission or any of its authorized representatives in the
14 performance of his duty under this chapter, or who wilfully violates
15 an order of the commission, shall have his license, permit, registration,
16 certificate of registration or certificate, as the case may be, re-
17 voked by the appropriate board under AS 08.01.010 for a period of not
18 more than one year.
