For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to discriminatory practices."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 18.80.270 is amended to read:

Sec. 18.80.270. PENALTY. A person, employer, labor organization

10

or employment agency, who or which wilfully engages in [AN] unlawful

11

discriminatory conduct prohibited by this chapter, or wilfully resists,

12

prevents, impedes or interferes with the commission or any of its

13

authorized representatives in the performance of duty under this

14

chapter, or who or which wilfully violates an order of the commission,

15

is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction by a court of competent

16

jurisdiction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500, or by

17

imprisonment [IN A JAIL] for not more than 30 days, or by both. If a

18

person, employer, labor organization or employment agency who is

19

convicted of such a misdemeanor practices a trade or profession or

20

operates a business under a permit or license issued by an agency of

21

the state or one of its political subdivisions, his permit or license

22

shall be suspended by the court for not more than one year; this

23

additional penalty applies only if the misdemeanor was related to the

24

practice of the trade or profession or the operation of the business.
