6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to restrictions on employment."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 14.14.140 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 14.14.140. RESTRICTION ON EMPLOYMENT. (a) School board  
10 members, or members of their immediate families, may not be employed  
11 by the school board except in case of an emergency and no other qualified  
12 person is available [UPON APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSIONER].

13 (b) Members of the immediate family of a chief school administra-  
14 tor may not be employed by the chief school administrator except in  
15 case of an emergency and no other qualified person is available [UPON  
16 APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSIONER].

17 (c) If a member of an officer's or employee's immediate family is  
18 elected to a position on the school board of the school district by  
19 whom the officer or employee is employed, the officer or employee must  
20 resign his position at the time the member-elect takes office.
