6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to old age assistance; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 47.25.430(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) Financial assistance shall be given under secs. 430 - 610
11 of this chapter, so far as practicable under the conditions in the
12 state, to every aged, needy resident of the state who has attained
13 the age of 65 years, who has not made a voluntary assignment or
14 transfer of property to qualify for assistance. Assistance shall be
15 in an amount which will provide the applicant with reasonable subsis-
16 tence compatible with decency and health in accordance with standards
17 established by the department, but may in no case exceed \$300 [\$250]
18 a calendar month. Direct payments for medical services and remedial
19 care may not be considered in determining the maximum amount payable.

20 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1971.
