6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to legislative per diem; and providing  
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 24.15.010 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 24.15.010. LEGISLATIVE PER DIEM. (a) The rate of per diem  
11 instead of subsistence for each member of the legislature is \$35 for  
12 the first 90 days of a legislative session. The per diem is also  
13 payable for those days of necessary travel to and from sessions.

14 (b) The per diem provided for in (a) of this section may not be  
15 paid to a member of the legislature for those days he is absent from  
16 the capital city during a day the legislature is in session unless he  
17 has been officially excused on legislative business or on a doctor's  
18 request.

19 (c) The per diem provided for in (a) of this section may not be  
20 paid to a member of the legislature for those days he is absent from  
21 a meeting of the legislature on personal business.

22 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approv-  
23 al or on the day it becomes law without approval.
