6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the 'normal retirement date' of  
7 public employees; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 39.35.680(11) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 (11) "normal retirement date" for an employee means the  
11 first day of the month following either his 55th birthday and eight  
12 years of credited service or his 20th year of credited service, which-  
13 ever is earlier;

14 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1971.
