6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the qualifications of notaries
7 public."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.50.020 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 44.50.020. QUALIFICATIONS. A person appointed a notary
11 public shall be, at the time of submitting his application [APPOINT-
12 MENT], a citizen of the United States and [OF THIS STATE AND] a resident
13 at least 19 years of age. In this section, "resident" means a person
14 who maintains his permanent place of abode in Alaska, and is in fact
15 living here.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 44.50.130 is amended to read:

17 Sec. 44.50.130. FILING OATH AND BOND. (a) An application for
18 a notary public commission shall include a statement under oath that
19 the applicant is a citizen of the United States and a resident of
20 Alaska, as defined in sec. 20 of this chapter.

21 (b) A person appointed a notary public shall file his bond and
22 the oath set out in AS 39.05.130 with the lieutenant governor. The
23 oath must be notarized and signed by the appointee.
