6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to student lobbyists; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 24.45.150 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 24.45.150. FEES FOR REGISTRATION OF LOBBYISTS. (a) The Depart-
11 ment of Administration shall charge and collect for each registration
12 as legislative counsel or legislative agent a basic fee of \$10 for
13 residents of the state, except as provided in (b) of this section,
14 which fee covers a permit to act as counsel or agent for the principal
15 Alaska resident contributor as set out, together with an additional
16 sum of \$5 for each additional resident contributor and \$25 for each
17 nonresident contributor, who is represented by that counsel or agent.
18 A registration fee of \$100 shall be charged nonresident persons
19 covering permit to act as counsel or agent for the principal contribu-
20 tor, whether or not a resident of this state, who is to be represented
21 by that counsel or agent, together with an additional sum of \$25 for
22 each nonresident contributor who is to be represented by him and \$5
23 for each additional resident contributor who is to be represented.
24 Upon payment of the fee, the Department of Administration shall enter
25 the required information in the appropriate docket and shall deliver to
26 the person paying the fee a receipt, in the form of a certificate,
27 certifying that the name of the person who is to act as counsel or
28 agent has been entered in the docket, and certifying also the subject
29 or subjects of legislation which he is to promote, advocate or oppose.

1 A separate certificate shall be issued with respect to each principal
2 that the counsel or agent is to represent. Whenever a further subject
3 of legislation arises which the counsel or agent is to promote, advocate
4 or oppose, he shall, before appearing as counsel before a committee
5 of the legislature or of either house or acting as agent with respect
6 to the legislation, comply with sec. 60 of this chapter and present
7 his certificate to the Department of Administration and have endorsed
8 on it by the department the fact that the employment of the certificate
9 holder covers promotion or otherwise of the additional legislation.
10 The certificate provided for in this section is valid from the beginning
11 of the session for which it is issued to the beginning of the next
12 regular or special session, and is prima facie evidence that the person
13 named in it has complied with this chapter.

14 (b) High school students who register as legislative agents, and
15 who officially represent their respective institutions shall pay a
16 basic fee of \$1.

17 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
18 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
