6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to employer's records; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.05.080 is amended to read:

10 Sec. AS 23.05.080. EMPLOYER'S RECORDS. An employer shall keep
11 an accurate record of the name, address and occupation of each person
12 employed by him, of the daily and weekly hours worked by each person,
13 and of the wages paid each pay period to each person. The record shall
14 be kept on file for at least three years at the place where an employee
15 is employed [ONE YEAR].

16 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
17 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
