For an Act entitled: "An Act exempting certain purchases of food from local  
7 sales taxation; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 29.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10

Sec. 29.30.120. EXEMPTIONS. Purchases made with food coupons

11

issued to low-income persons under the Federal Food Stamp Act of 1964,

12

as amended, are exempt from sales taxes levied and collected by an

13

organized borough or city of any class, whether home rule or otherwise.

\* Sec. 2. If an Act is passed by the Seventh Alaska Legislature repealing  
15 the provisions of AS 29.30, the new section added by this Act is unaffected  
16 unless specifically referred to in the repealer, and the revisor of statutes  
17 shall make an appropriate relocation of the section.

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1972.
